When walking back toward the kennel from the driveway a male dog named Chief, with id 34-A-0226-1, was loose. The licensee stated that the dog had climbed out of the exercise yard.

Housing facilities for dogs must be designed and constructed so that they are structurally sound. They must be kept in good repair, and they must protect the animals from injury, contain the animals securely, and restrict other animals from entering.

Ensure that the exercise pen is constructed to prevent dogs from jumping or climbing out to prevent injury or death to the dogs.

A schedule to check teeth and skin and coat must be added, and approved by the attending veterinarian, to the program of veterinary care. The vaccine name must be added to the program of veterinary care and approved by the veterinarian. A schedule for testing for heartworm must be on the program of veterinary care and approved by the attending veterinarian. Medical records must be kept on all dogs.
