Fecal testing was not performed at the frequency described in the program of veterinary care. Fecal testing is important for ensuring animals do not have any intestinal parasites. Each dealer much follow an appropriate program of veterinary care for dogs that includes the sampling and treating for pests (including worms, coccidia, and giardia) in accordance with a schedule approved by the attending. The applicant must have a fecal test performed.

This is a 1st Re-License Inspection for a Class "A" license. The inspection and exit briefing were conducted with the applicant.
