Primary enclosures.

Two enclosures had dogs in it that required more space than what the enclosures provided. The first enclosure had two pomeranians. The two dogs measured 20 inches and 22 inches respectively. These two dogs together required 1,460 square inches of space. The enclosure they were in measured 48 inches by 30 inches and only provided 1,440 square inches of space. The enclosure was short by 20 square inches of space. Another enclosure contained three boston terriers. The dogs measured 23 inches, 22 inches, and 19 inches respectively. Together they required 2,250 square inches of space. They were in an enclosure that measured 48 by 30 inches and provided 1,440 square inches of space. They were in an enclosure that measured 48 by 30 inches and provided 1,440 square inches of space. The enclosure was short by 810 square inches of space.

Cage space requirements ensure that the dogs have enough room to move about freely within their enclosures. It minimizes the dogs from stepping or sitting in their feces or urine and also minimizes the spread of disease. The licensee must ensure that all enclosures containing dogs and puppies have enough floor space to meet the minimum floor space requirements for the number of and the size of the dogs in that enclosure.
