#### Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

The licensee has not had the attending veterinarian visit the facility monthly, as written in the program of vet care. While the licensee stated the attending vet will frequent the facility monthly in the near future, the attending vet is currently visiting the facility semiannually. The facility shall include formal arrangements with a written program of veterinary care for their attending veterinarian consultant arrangements and follow that written guidance.

### 2.75(a)(1)

#### Records: Dealers and exhibitors.

The facility uses cage cards as the record of acquisition for the dogs born at the facility. There were several litters of puppies with their dams in Building 2 missing the following information on the cage cards: USDA number, dam's microchip number, puppy's sex, breed, color and any distinct markings.

Accurate acquisition information is necessary for APHIS officials to make positive identification of animals during inspection and to properly trace their movements. The licensee shall make, keep, and maintain an approved method of documentation which fully and correctly disclose all information concerning each dog purchased or otherwise acquired, owned, held, or otherwise in his or her possession or under his or her control, or which is transported, euthanized, sold, or otherwise disposed of by that dealer. The records shall include any offspring born of any animal while in his or her possession or under his or her control.

The licensee must record the acquisition information on an approved document for all puppies and ensure all required acquisition information is properly and accurately documented at all times.

### 3.13(b)(3) Repeat

#### Veterinary care for dogs.

The dates for administration of treatment for one dog at the facility were not completed in full. One adult male (MC #933000320230157) received eye drops for a chronic condition. Although the facility documented the initial management of eye drops, the remaining dates of duration has not been notated.

Adequate record keeping is necessary to ensure the health of animals and to ensure that the guidance of the attending veterinarian is being followed. The facility must keep and maintain the names of all vaccines and treatments and the dates of administration given to dogs at the facility.
