Male Bulldog (microchip 7E10334920, tattoo #5) has an abnormal condition of the eyes. The center of the cornea of both eyes is cloudy and the white of the right eye is moderately reddened and the white of the left eye is slightly reddened. A thick greenish mucousy discharge is located along the bottom eyelid of both eyes and attached to the hair along the eyelids. The dog had received treatment for the eyes between April 19th-24th, but is currently receiving no treatment.

Male bulldog (microchip 7E10334877, tattoo #7) has an abnormal condition of the eyes. The white of the right eye is moderately reddened and the white of the left eye is slightly reddened. A thick greenish mucousy discharge is located across the surface of the right eye and along the bottom eyelid of both eyes. The dog had received treatment for the eyes between April 19th-24th, but is currently receiving no treatment.

Female bulldog (microchip 4982829, tattoo #2) has an abnormal condition of the eyes. The center of the cornea of both eyes is cloudy and the white of the right eye is moderately reddened and the white of the left eye is slightly reddened. A thick greenish mucousy discharge is located along the bottom eyelid of both eyes and dried discharge is attached to the hair surrounding the eyes. The condition of the dog's eyes has not been noticed and no treatment is currently being provided.

Female bulldog (microchip 7E10334736, tattoo #138) has an abnormal condition of the foot. A round dark colored growth is located between the toes on the right front foot. The condition of the dog's foot has not been noticed and no treatment is currently being provided.

Abnormal conditions of the eyes and feet could cause pain and discomfort to the animals.

Dealers must use appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries. The licensee must have these dogs evaluated by a veterinarian for an accurate diagnosis and to develop an appropriate treatment plan. The licensee must ensure each dog receives adequate veterinary care at all times.

The inspector measured the width of a front foot of two of the dogs and found the foot to be 3/4 of an inch wide for one dog and one inch wide for the other dog. The openings in the flooring measured over an inch wide. Openings in flooring large enough to allow a dog's foot to pass through could cause injury to the animal and affect its ability to move around in a normal manner.

Primary enclosures must have floors that are constructed in a manner that protects the dogs' feet and legs from injury, and that, if of mesh or slatted construction, do not allow the dogs' feet to pass through any openings in the floor. The licensee must alter the floor in a manner that protects the animals from injury and eliminates the ability of their feet to pass through any openings. The licensee must ensure the enclosure flooring is safe for the dogs at all times.
