Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

Female pug puppy (DOB 04-March-2023, Dam ID #9690) has poor eye health and nasal discharge. The surface of the right eye is completely cloudy and has a blueish color. A small amount of dried yellow colored discharge is attached to the hair around the eye. The left eye is sealed shut by dry yellow colored discharge and a wet grey discharge is around both nostrils. The puppy has not been evaluated by a veterinarian and is not receiving any treatment. Poor eye health could cause pain and discomfort to the dog and discharge from the eyes and nostrils could indicate an underlying illness.

Each dealer must use appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries. The puppy must be evaluated by a veterinarian for an accurate diagnosis and to develop an effective treatment plan. The licensee must ensure that each animal receives adequate veterinary care at all times.

To be corrected by: The licensee was verbally instructed at the time of the inspection to have the puppy evaluated by the end of business 27-April-2023.

## **Inspection Report**

Eight dogs and their acquisition information are missing from APHIS form 7005 (Record of Acquisition of Dogs and Cats on Hand). The acquisition information is necessary for APHIS officials to identify dogs and to trace their movements.

Each dealer shall make, keep, and maintain records which fully and correctly disclose the required information for each dog purchased or otherwise acquired, owned, held, in possession of, or which is transported, euthanized, sold or otherwise disposed of. The licensee must add the eight dogs and their acquisition information to APHIS form 7005. The licensee must ensure that all required documents are complete with all necessary information.

To be corrected by: APHIS form 7005 must be kept current beginning on 24-April-2023.

#### 3.7(c)

#### Compatible grouping.

A 3-month-old dachshund puppy is housed with two adult pugs. Neither of the pugs are the puppy's dam or foster dam. Housing puppies with adults that are not their dam could cause injury to the puppy should the adult become aggressive or interfere with the puppy's access to food should the adult display resource guarding behaviors.

Puppies 4 months of age or less may not be housed in the same primary enclosure with adult dogs other than their dams or foster dams. The licensee must either house the puppy alone or with pen mates that meet the requirements for compatible housing. The licensee must ensure that all dogs housed in the same enclosure are compatible at all times.

To be corrected by: The puppy was moved to a new enclosure at the time of the inspection.

### **Inspection Report**

On 04-April-2023, female pug (microchip #000005830709) was examined by the attending veterinarian for a concern with the left eye. No medical record exists documenting this examination along with the results and treatment plan.

The facility had six dogs tested for heartworm and fecals done for eight dogs. No medical record exists that contains the identification of which dogs were tested or the results of these tests.

Failure to create a complete medical record may interfere with the ability of APHIS officials to determine if the animals are receiving adequate veterinary care.

Each dealer shall keep copies of medical records that include the identification of the animal, dates and results of all screening, routine, or other required or recommended tests or examinations. The licensee must document on a medical record the identification of the animal, the results of all examinations and tests performed, and any treatment plans. The licensee must ensure that all medical records are complete and contain all required information.

To be corrected by: The licensee was verbally instructed at the time of the inspection to have a documented medical record for the condition of the eye of female pug (#000005830709) by end of business 27-April-2023. The facility must begin keeping all other medical records starting on 24-April-2023.
