There was a bottle of expired ear wash in the dog intake container (that is used currently when animals are brought into the facility), Sampson is obtaining expired gabapentin and expired parvo tests were located in the refrigerator. Expired medications do not ensure that the medication are effective at treating disease or illness and the health of the animal may suffer. Each dealer shall use appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries. The licensee must ensure that regulated animals obtain medications that are in date.

Housing facilities, general.

Three primary enclosures housing dogs contained broken glass partitions between dog runs. One primary enclosure contained an extension cord draped down low enough for the canine named Charlie to touch it. Broken glass partitions not kept in good repair may cause injury to the dogs inside the enclosures. Unprotected electrical wires in enclosures pose a risk of shock, electrocution, and strangulation. The electrical wires need to be oriented in such a way that the animals cannot interact with them. Housing facilities for dogs must be designed and constructed so that they are structurally sound. They must be kept in good repair, and they must protect the animals from injury, contain the animals securely, and restrict other animals from entering.
