In the small eastern most kennel building there is a spot that has been dug out between the first and second outdoor run on the south side that allows that dogs from the two enclosures to move back of forth under the fencing. Crawling under the fencing could cause the dogs injury and the is an increased risk of escape or incompatible dogs coming into contact.

Primary enclosures must contain dogs securely.

Cleaning, sanitization, housekeeping, and pest control.

In the eastern most building that was a buildup of rodent droppings in the building between the enclosures. There a was mouse in a trap. The rodent droppings and mouse were directly next to a primary enclosure.

Exposure to rodents and rodent droppings is a risk for spread of disease and can cause illness to animals.

An effective program to control pest and reduce contamination by the pests in animal areas must be established.
