Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

The vaccines for the dogs are not being stored at the proper temperature. The temperature inside the refrigerator containing the vaccines is 52 degrees F according to the inspector's Kestrel. The label on the vaccines state they are to be stored between 35-46 degrees F. Storing vaccines at an inappropriate temperature may interfere with their ability to be effective which could leave dogs without proper protection against serious and deadly diseases. Each dealer must use appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose and treat diseases and injuries. The licensee must store the vaccines at the appropriate temperature and ensure that all other medical products are properly stored at all times in order to support the health of the dogs.
