There were four dogs noted during inspection to have excessively long toenails:

- White Female Bichon #8933

- Red Female Cavalier King Charles Spaniel #3073
- Black and Tan Female Yorkie #6202
- White and Grey Female Shih Tzu #2384

Long toenails are problematic because they can be easily broken. Long toenails may also cause abnormal ambulation and can lead to early arthritic changes in the toes. The licensee must ensure that preventative care such as properly trimmed toenails be performed on a regular basis and as often as necessary to avoid overgrowth and any subsequent injuries. Correct from November 5, 2023, onward.
