## 2.40(b)(3)

#### Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

An 8 year old male chihuahua named "Elvis" contained a mobile front incisor and moderate diffuse dental calculi. The condition had not been observed by the licensee and had not been communicated to the AV. Daily observations of all animals are important to assess their health and well-being, so problems can be communicated to the AV or treated as directed in the Veterinary care plan. Correct from this day forward by ensuring daily observations are done in a thorough manner to ensure that all problems are addressed quickly.

## 2.75(a)(1)

### **Records: Dealers and exhibitors.**

3 adult dogs over 4 months of age have not been added to the facility's Record of Acquisition of Dogs and Cats on Hand (APHIS form 7005). Accurate acquisition information is necessary for APHIS officials to make positive identification of animals during inspection and to properly trace their movements. The licensee shall make, keep, and maintain an approved method of documentation which fully and correctly discloses all information concerning each dog purchased or otherwise acquired, owned, held, or otherwise in his or her possession or under his or her control, or which is transported, euthanized, sold, or otherwise disposed of by that dealer. The records shall include any offspring born of any animal while in his or her possession or under his or her control. The licensee must record the acquisition information on an approved document for all dogs and ensure all required acquisition information is properly and accurately documented at all times. ## 3.13(a)(3)

### Veterinary care for dogs.

A five and a half month old chihuahua named Mason has not received a rabies vaccine. Per the program of veterinary care, the dog is to receive a Rabies vaccine at 16 weeks of age. Not vaccinating all adults dogs for rabies doesn't ensure the dogs are adequately protected. All adult dogs must be vaccinated for rabies in accordance with the plan from the Attending Veterinarian.

# **Inspection Report**

#### Veterinary care for dogs.

Medical records were not complete for 12 dogs at the facility after completion of annual exams on 8/5/2023. While the facility maintained receipts showing the veterinary visit and diagnostics/preventatives performed, there were no medical records documenting the date the problem occurred, or examination findings to describe the extent of the injury, test results, and next steps moving forward for treatment and care. Incomplete records do not allow the identification of medical problems as they arise, does not ensure adequate care is provided, and does not allow close monitoring of conditions as they progress. Dealers must keep copies of medical records for dogs and make them available during inspection.
