Cleaning, sanitization, housekeeping, and pest control.

During inspection it was found that there was a buildup of hair in the corners of primary enclosures. There was organic material built up on the outside of the doors of the primary enclosures where the dogs could reach with their paws. There was organic build-up on some of the interior walls and the doors to the exterior portion of the enclosure.

A buildup of material in the enclosure increases the risk of disease, pests, insects, and orders that can adversely effect the health of the dogs.

Primary enclosures must be sanitized at least once every two weeks using a method approved in Part 3 section 3.11 (b)(3) to prevent the accumulation of dirt, debris, food waste, excreta, and other disease hazards. Correction Date: January 15, 2024
