Veterinary care for dogs.

Approximately 10 percent of the dogs were identified with moderate to severe dental disease on their annual exam on April 13, 2024. However, their individual medical records do not indicate a plan for treatment and care. Although the program of veterinary care states that licensee will "scale" the teeth as needed, there is no documentation on any of the affected dog's medical records indicating that their severity of dental disease warrants "scaling" of the teeth nor is there any documentation that this treatment was performed.

It is important to document all planned treatments and procedures performed on individual dogs that have had a problem identified on their physical exam to ensure they are receiving appropriate veterinary care. Correct by May 30, 2024
