Cleaning, sanitization, housekeeping, and pest control.

Enclosures are not being spot cleaned daily. There was a build up of feces in multiple indoor boxes that needs to be removed. Fecal and food waste must be removed from primary enclosures daily to prevent soiling of the dogs and reduce odors.

3.11(b)(2)

Cleaning, sanitization, housekeeping, and pest control.

Primary enclosures are not being cleaned and sanitized at least once every two weeks. There is a build up of hair hanging down from the wire mesh floor. This accumulation of hair traps urine, dust and debris in and around the primary enclosures. In addition, there is feces and hair trapped between wire mesh and the wood support beams around the outdoor enclosures. These primary enclosures must be cleaned and sanitized at least once every two weeks for the health of the dogs.

3.13(a)(3)

Veterinary care for dogs.

The facility has two cavalier puppies that are 5 months of age. According to the vaccine schedule established by the veterinarian, they should have had their first rabies vaccine at 3 months of age. These dogs must be vaccinated per the schedule established by the attending veterinarian for their health and well being and to ensure she has adequate authority over preventative health of the kennel.
