Cleaning, sanitization, housekeeping, and pest control.

The facility representative disclosed that primary enclosures for dogs are spot-cleaned daily using a detergent, but are sanitized monthly with a disinfectant. Primary enclosures must be sanitized at least once every 2 weeks using a prescribed method as inadequate sanitization may promote growth and spread of pathogens. The facility must address the frequency of sanitization to minimize disease hazards.
