#### 2.40(b)(2) Direct Repeat

#### Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

Two dogs were found displaying signs of lameness during the inspection. Neither dog had been assessed for lameness by a licensed veterinarian.

- "Gus", a male West Highland White terrier (ID#348173) was observed holding his right rear leg up and reluctantly using the leg when walking around his enclosure. The lameness was intermittent and when excited Gus would sometimes use the leq. However, he would return to displaying the limp after he calmed down.

- Male husky puppy (no name or ID) was observed "three legged lame" and carrying his right rear leg. When encouraged to walk outside of his enclosure he was very reluctant to use the right rear leg.

Both animals must be evaluated by a licensed veterinarian within 24 hours of the inspection date. The applicant must keep records of the veterinary visit and any treatment and submit those records to APHIS inspectors for review. Correct by 27 September 2024

## Housing facilities, general.

- There was standing water and fluids around the surface portion of the septic tank located approximately 20 feet from the kennel. There was a distinct odor of sewage and waste in this area. Noxious odors are a source of irritation to the dogs, and can also be an attractant to pests and insects. The applicant must ensure that all waste is being adequately drained from the kennel.

## 3.6(a)(1)

## Primary enclosures.

- Three indoor enclosures had lower metal cage bars showing excessive areas of rust that had formed holes in the metal. This is a potential source of injury to the enclosed animals, and also makes cleaning and sanitation of these sections much less effective. The applicant must repair or replace these rusted areas. All physical structures must be in compliance by 15-OCT-2024.

This is a (2nd) Re-License Inspection for a Class "A" license. The inspection and exit briefing were conducted with the applicant.
