* Two metal self-feeders use to feed two adult dogs metal surfaces was rusting and corroding. These areas where along the side of the feeder and the area where to dogs eat out of.

Four enclosure's outside the main building have black powder coated pipe framed panels used to house four adult dogs. The metal framing's surface along the bottom divider and front panels has paint coming off exposing the bare metal. These areas are excessively corroding, rusting and or flaking. The mentioned excessively rusting and corroding surfaces can affect the structural strength of the surfaces and or prevent required cleaning and sanitation increasing disease hazards for the dogs.

For the structural integrity and required sanitation and cleaning, all rusty, flaking and corroding metal surfaces must be kept free of excessive rust.
