### 3.6(a)(1)

#### Primary enclosures.

There is damage to a bottom corner of 1 wired primary enclosure, resulting in several inches of mangled wire protruding into the enclosure and creating larger openings in the remaining wire. Damaged wire may injure the dog and compromise the structural integrity of the enclosure. Primary enclosures must be structurally sound and kept in good repair to minimize risks to the dog contained therein.

### 3.6(c)(1)(i)

#### Primary enclosures.

The dogs are kept indoors during feeding times and overnight in enclosures that do not meet minimum space requirements. Ten dogs are kept in enclosures offering 7.11 square feet of floor space. These dogs ranged between 38 inches and 46 inches long, necessitating minimum space of 12.25 square feet and 18.78 square feet, respectively. Insufficient space may prevent dogs from being able to rest or move comfortably as well as restricting expression of normal behaviors. Primary enclosures must provide for the minimum required floor space for each dog as described in this section.

## Watering

The facility does not offer continuous access to water for all dogs. Water is not offered to one 24-week-old dog overnight for housebreaking purposes. In addition, while all dogs are offered fresh buckets of water during kenneled feeding times, 5 occupied kennels contained empty buckets that had not yet been replenished since the dogs finished drinking. No dogs exhibited evidence of dehydration at the time of inspection. The facility must ensure all dogs on the premises have continuous access to potable water unless restricted by the attending veterinarian.
