Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

There was a bottle of medication formulated by the Attending Veterinarian in the medical supply cabinet with a label that could not be read. The licensee indicated it was Ponazuril and used for treating intestinal parasites. Similar bottles with illegible labels can be confused, resulting in the wrong product being used. Animal health could be adversely impacted by the administration of an incorrect medication or the incorrect dosage, route, or frequency. The licensee must make sure that medications and other products are clearly labeled with the name, concentration of the medication, the dose, dosage frequency, route of administration, and expiration date.
