#### Time and method of identification.

Three dogs were observed to be have missing ID tags; the licensee said the collar adjustment rings have been breaking. Also, seven new dogs to the kennel (acquired about 2 months ago) do not have official tags and tag numbers assigned to them. Proper dog identification is required and can be important in animal health tracking. Ensure that each dog is properly identified with the required tag on a collar that is safe and made of material generally considered acceptable to pet owners as a means of identifying their pet dogs.

#### 2.75(a)(1)(iv)

#### Records: Dealers and exhibitors.

Some of the disposition forms (APHIS 7006) had a transporter noted, however lacked the name and address of the buyer or receiver. The name and address of the buyer/receiver must be correctly recorded on the disposition form and can be important for animal health tracing. Ensure that APHIS 7006 has the buyer/reciever recorded on it correctly.

#### Minimum age requirements.

Three cavapoo puppies were sold and picked up for transport on 3-19-2024 by a broker that were born on 1-29-2024. These puppies would not have been 8 weeks old until 3/26/2024. Allowing puppies younger than 8 weeks old to be transported in commerce isn't permitted and can cause health problems in puppies. Ensure that all puppies are 8 weeks of age and weaned prior to permitting them to be transported in commerce.

# Primary enclosures.

Six weaned puppies are housed in a sheltered enclosure that was made in part of the walkway. There is a kennel stored between a door of bare wood and the fence is made of bare wood. The stored objects that puppies can access and bare wood make this area difficult to clean and sanitize. Ensure that if dogs or puppies are to be housed in this area that it can

#### Veterinary care for dogs.
