Veterinary care for dogs.

The facility is not following the Program of Vet Care (PVC) for vaccinations. The current Program of Vet Care prescribes for the rabies vaccination to be performed at 18 weeks of age, then at 1 year, then every 3 years after booster at 1 year of age. The distemper and parvovirus vaccinations are to be given every 4 weeks up to 18 weeks of age, then given yearly after that.

Five adult dogs had no record of a current distemper, parvovirus, or rabies vaccination:

Failure to follow the PVC leaves the dogs susceptible to distemper, parvovirus, and rabies, which are viruses that, if contracted, will cause pain and distress. It is also important for dogs to be vaccinated since rabies is a disease that can infect humans. Vaccinations are also important in pregnant and nursing dogs because they will pass immunity from the vaccines onto their offspring. Correct by administering all of the vaccines required by the Animal Welfare Act (distemper, parvovirus, and rabies) in accordance with a schedule approved by the Attending Veterinarian and vaccine manufacturer recommendations. Correct by: July 31, 2024.
