The refrigerator in the kennel that stores vaccines is not working. Upon opening the refrigerator, it was noted that the temperature inside was that of room temperature. When the temperature was measured, it was found that the inside of the refrigerator was 86 Degrees Fahrenheit. Vaccines that were in the refrigerator stated that they must be stored between 35-46 Degrees Fahrenheit. Vaccines that are not stored appropriately may no longer be effective and may not properly protect dogs from diseases. Each dealer shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include the availability of appropriate facilities, personnel, equipment and services. Correct by ensuring the availability of appropriate equipment that can adequately store vaccines. Correct by 20-AUG-2024.
