## Cleaning, sanitization, housekeeping, and pest control.

Food receptacles are not being cleaned and sanitized as often as needed. At least four dogs' metal food bowls in four enclosures had smeared, dried feces or a thick buildup of dark brown organic material on the inside of the bowls. At least one bowl contained fresh dog food. Failure to properly clean and sanitize the bowls may result in the spread of infectious diseases, insects, pests, and odors that may affect the dogs' health. Used primary enclosures and food and water receptacles for dogs and cats must be sanitized at least once every 2 weeks using one of the methods prescribed in paragraph (b)(3) of this section, and more often if necessary to prevent an accumulation of dirt, debris, food waste, excreta, and other disease hazards.
