
2024 USDA Inspection Program Audit

This report only reflects USDA dog and cat breeders and brokers (licenses A and B) and covers the time period of January 1st 2024 to December 31st, 2024

Methodology: Each month our research team monitors every USDA inspection report that is publicly posted and we update each breeder's information in our database. We track and analyze the inspectors who are on the ground, all of the licensed dog and cat facilities, and the violations received.

Most Frequent Violations:

- **26%** for Veterinary Care for Dogs
- **13%** for Attending Veterinarian and Adequate Veterinary Care
- **11%** for Housing Facilities
 - **9%** for Records





The following states had the highest percentage of violations based on the number of licensees inspected in 2024.



States with the most inspections (ranked) followed by their percentage of violations for 2024:

Missouri, 3% Indiana, 8.5% Ohio, 29% Iowa, 13% Pennsylvania, 29%

These states made up 59% of inspections performed at A and B Facilities.

Benji Tracker:

These numbers are the current status of active USDA-licensed cat and dog failities from our database, the largest and most comprehensive of its kind. Statuses are checked monthly using USDA records.
