## 3.1(a)

#### Housing facilities, general.

The ground horizontal bar of the wire mesh/chain link fence and gate in the cement yard of the adoption building is no longer structurally sound. The horizontal bar is rusted with holes and sharp points in the rusted areas. Dogs and puppies which are allowed play time in this area may injure themselves on the rusted areas. Correct by ensuring the fence and gate are kept in good repair and protect the animals from injury. Correct by March 21, 2024.

#### 3.2(d)

## Indoor housing facilities.

The cat cottage pressed wood flooring is no longer impervious to moisture. Moisture has seeped through floor seams in the open space where cats have free roam, causing the underlying grey pressed board to wick moisture and swell up through the floor seams. One cat enclosure that sits open ended on top of the wood floor has an approximately two-inch diameter compromised area in which the wood has pulled away and the previous underlying vinyl floor is exposed. Floors and surfaces that absorb water, urine, and other fluids, cannot be effectively cleaned and sanitized, which can damage structural integrity and harbor disease. Correct by ensuring the floors and walls of indoor housing facilities, and any other surfaces in contact with animals are impervious to moisture. Correct by May 22, 2024.
