3.1(b)

Housing facilities, general.

In the southwest corner in the outdoor sheltered area; storage of things such as lumber and buckets is next to a run that houses two dogs. The area isn't where dogs can contact but, the stored lumber and buckets next to the dogs has a buildup of soiled shavings and dust and the manner of storage would make it difficult to clean out the old shavings from this area, creating risks for germs or areas for pests to live in. Ensure that storage of items in animal areas is limited to materials necessary for proper husbandry practices and that the storage does not interfere with normal husbandry practices such as cleaning floor areas next to dogs.

3.6(a)(2)(x)

Primary enclosures.

A litter of puppies was observed for about 5 minutes on a raised run that has a part solid floor area and part mesh. One smaller puppy in the litter was observed to have a foot sometimes pass through when going over to the mesh floor. The larger puppies in the litter were observed to not have any feet pass through the mesh. Ensure that puppies are housed on a floor that does not allow their feet to pass through any openings. (The facility had a completely solid floor enclosure available during inspection to move the affected puppy w/ litter mates to).

3.13(a)

Veterinary care for dogs.

Records indicate the facility has an Attending Veterinarian and is up to date on physical exams and rabies vaccinations for the adult dogs, however the licensee didn't have a written program of veterinary care (PVC) that was available for inspection. A written PVC is required and helps ensure that a plan for adequate veterinary care and husbandry guidance is in place for the animals. Ensure to contact the attending veterinarian to obtain a written and signed PVC and maintain it available for inspection at the facility.

This is a 1st Re-License Inspection for a Class A license. The inspection and exit briefing were conducted with the applicant.
