Nine dogs to be housed short-term at the facility and one of the facility's breeding dogs (Viola) did not have tags for official identification. Official identification such as tags are important for husbandry tracking of animals. Ensure that each dog has official identification as required.

Form of official tag.

Tags at the facility identify each dog by a unique name, however an identification number that is serially numbered is required to uniquely identify each dog. Serially numbering each tag helps track animals for husbandry purposes over time. Ensure to add identification numbers for each tag as required.

Records: Dealers and exhibitors.

Nine dogs are being housed at the facility short-term and have not been added to the record of acquisition with the required information. Up to date records for dogs on hand can be important for animal health tracking purposes. Dogs acquired in the facility must be added to APHIS 7005 with the required information.

Veterinary care for dogs.

Five dogs were observed to be overdue for maintaining unmatted hair coats (dog names Music, Laddy, Cherry, Goldi, and Viola). The licensee said that haircuts for dogs was programmed for this week, however the dogs had matted hair coats and need to be maintained free from matted hair coats. Matted hair can cause skin problems and discomfort in dogs. Ensure to groom affected dogs and adjust the routine of care to prevent matted hair coats.
