Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

Four dogs were observed to have fleas (#60 Brown teddy bear, #59 White F Bichon, #14 F Mini Teddy Bear, and #6 White Pomeranian). Other dogs in the kennel were seen occasionally scratching, which can be a sign of fleas. The presence of fleas was pointed out to the licensee and isn't under any treatment. Fleas can cause discomfort and spread sickness in dogs. Ensure that the attending veterinarian is contacted about the fleas in the kennel and that a flea treatment program is put into place for the whole kennel to protect each dog.

Records: Dealers and exhibitors.

Three dispositions did not have the name and/or address of whom puppies were sold to. The address that records where dogs were sold to can be important for animal health tracking. Ensure to obtain and maintain a record of name and address of whom dogs are sold to.

2.75(a)(1)(v)

Records: Dealers and exhibitors.

Three disposition records lacked a date of when puppies were sold and/or picked up by the buyer. A date of sale can be important in animal health tracking. Ensure that a date of sale is obtained and maintained on the Record of Disposition when selling dogs/puppies.

3.1(c)(3)

Housing facilities, general.

The floors on the inside of the kennel have shavings that are put by the water dishes to absorb splashed water, but these wet soiled shavings are not removed daily. Also, the outdoor runs have shavings on the floor to absorb waste but have excreta that is not being spot cleaned daily. Lack of daily spot cleaning on hard surfaces doesn't maintain the kennel clean and can increase risk of sickness. Ensure that hard surfaces that dogs can touch are spot cleaned daily and are

Haircoats must be maintained in a manner that prevents matted hair coats. Ensure that these dogs' hair coats are trimmed so that they are not matted and that all dogs' coats are maintained unmatted.
