Records: Dealers and exhibitors.

The facility used to have a computerized method of maintaining acquisition records for puppies, however a change over to paper records has led to incomplete acquisition information for puppies from small unlicensed breeders. Acquisition records must be kept on APHIS 7005 Record of Acquisition and Dogs and Cats on Hand unless a variance-approved computerized record-keeping system is used. Complete acquisition records are required and can be important for animal health tracing if needed.

APHIS 7006 for 5 puppies sold to a pet store on 3/17/2023 was not available for inspection. The licensee thinks that it was misplaced and that a copy can be acquired from the pet store. APHIS 7006 is a required form to maintain on file for dogs sold for at least one year after sale. Ensure to maintain a copies of APHIS 7006 for each dog/puppy disposition.

Procurement of dogs, cats, and other animals; dealers.

Acquisition for puppies bought from small unlicensed breeders certifying that they maintain 4 or fewer breeding female dogs/cats and the dogs/cats were born and raised on that person's premises haven't been regularly obtained and kept by the facility. The licensee reports that they do verify this information from any unlicensed breeder they buy from; but regulations require that certification is obtained. When acquiring any dog/cat from any person not licensed with USDA, ensure to obtain certification that the animals were born and raised on that person's premises and that the person does not maintain more than four breeding female dogs and/or cats.
