Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

A white female mini-poodle, ID 219, DOB 9-7-22, was observed to be non-weight bearing lame on the right front leg. The wrist joint was moderately swollen. The licensee reported the dog jumped off the grooming table (approximately 4 feet high) 2 days ago and has been limping since then. The licensee has not contacted the attending veterinarian and has not administered any treatments.

Lameness is an important indicator of pain and/or musculoskeletal abnormality. A failure to properly identify lame dogs delays proper identification of the underlying cause which delays treatment and can prolong suffering.

The licensee must communicate with the attending veterinarian to evaluate this animal and determine an appropriate plan for diagnosis and treatment.
