Cleaning, sanitization, housekeeping, and pest control.

Rodent feces was found in several areas of the dog kennel. There were numerous mouse droppings observed on the floor of the storage areas and on the shelves holding the grooming supplies and facility records. The facility has been setting traps in the kennel, but their current program does not appear to be effective in controlling mammalian pests in these areas.

Failure to maintain an effective program to control mammalian pests can have a negative impact on the the health of the animals through the spread of disease by contamination of animal areas and feed.

The licensee must correct by implementing an effective pest control program in all animal areas. Correct by: 08/9/2023.
