Access and inspection of records and property; submission of itineraries.

During this inspection the inspector was prevented from gathering the evidence needed to evaluate the facility. After receiving numerous verbal challenges from members of the public and from employees of this licensee about taking videos of the handling of animals during the auction, one individual purposely stood between the inspector and the animals so as to block the ability to take videos during this inspection.

Interfering with the inspection process by blocking the video taping of areas of non-compliance hinders the inspectors ability to enforce the Animal Welfare Act (AWA). This operator of an auction must allow APHIS officials to inspect and photograph (to include video) the facilities, property and animals as they consider necessary to enforce the provisions of the act, the regulations and the standards of the AWA.

2.131(b)(1) Critical

Handling of animals.

A ring-tailed lemur was handled inappropriately during the auction. During the auction, an individual in the auction arena attempted to remove the lemur from its travel enclosure. This individual was holding the enclosure in one hand and attempting to pull the lemur out of the enclosure by its tail. The lemur resisted coming out of the cage, so the individual

held the lemur's tail and preceded to pull harder. Again, the lemur resisted even more by grabbing both sides of the enclosure with its forefeet. Finally, after the individual gave one last hard pull the lemur came out of the enclosure. While this was happening, the enclosure was observed shaking.

Rough and inappropriate handling of animals can result in stress, injury, and trauma. All facility personnel must handle all animals as expeditiously and carefully as possible in a manner that does not cause trauma, overheating, excessive cooling, physical harm, or unnecessary discomfort.
