Housing facilities, general.

The outdoor housing enclosure containing 1 adult husky, and 7 juvenile huskies have multiple holes dug into the ground leaving large gaps underneath both sides of the fencing in the enclosure. During the time of inspection, a single juvenile husky was observed to crawl under the fence through one of the holes into the adjacent enclosure housing 2 juvenile Bernese Mountain dogs. The juvenile husky immediately crawled back into it's enclosure.

The dogs could potentially become stuck under the fencing, escape, or be injured due to not properly maintaining housing facilities in good repair. Housing facilities for dogs must be designed and constructed so they are structurally sound. They must be kept in good repair, and they must protect the animals from injury, contain the animals securely, and restrict other animals from entering.
