During the inspection there were approximately 26 out of 30 expired medications – all of which were being used, or intended to be used, on the animals. This was confirmed by a facility representative. The expiration and 'discard by' dates ranged from 2020 to March 2023. Usage of expired drugs can cause injury and/or suffering to the animals and are ineffective for their intended use. Each dealer shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include the use of appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries.

Primary enclosures.

There were three miniature schnauzer puppies housed in a primary enclosure where the height of the enclosure was insufficient. The ears of two of the three animals would fold over up against the surface of the top of the enclosure whenever they would stand up in a normal posture. Adequate space to make normal postural movements is an essential aspect of ensuring the health and wellbeing of the animals contained therein as it avoids creating stress/anxiety and discomfort, among other things. The interior height of a primary enclosure must be at least 6 inches higher than the head
