Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

A male Shih Tzu named "Gordy" (tag #213) had a loose tooth on the upper left side of its mouth. The licensee had observed this a couple days prior, but the Attending Veterinarian had not been contacted and treatment had not been started for this dog. Dental issues can be painful and can lead to systemic disease and even death. The licensee must contact the Attending Veterinarian and a treatment plan must be initiated for this dog. Correct by 2/2/24.

3.1(a)

Housing facilities, general.

An enclosure containing three adult dogs had a chewed up wall with jagged edges. An outdoor enclosure had a gate with a broken hinge on the bottom. The door to the enclosure was somewhat lopsided with an opening that could potentially allow the dogs to escape. Two more enclosures containing 1 adult and 6 puppies in one and 1 adult and 3 puppies in the other both had broken wire flooring where the feet could potentially fall through and the dogs could injure themselves.

Enclosures in disrepair could cause the dogs in those enclosures to injure themselves and could also allow for the dogs in those enclosures to escape. The enclosures must be kept in good repair, and they must protect the animals from injury and contain the animals securely. Correct by 2/7/24.

This inspection and exit interview were conducted with the licensee.
