The applicant doesn't have an exercise plan for the dogs. Failure to have an exercise plan and have it reviewed by the attending veterinarian approve the exercise plan does not ensure that the exercise received by the dogs is appropriate and their health and well-being may suffer.

Dealers must develop, document, and follow an appropriate plan to provide dogs with the opportunity for exercise and the plan must be approved by the attending veterinarian. The applicant must have the attending veterinarian review and approve the exercise plan in order to support the health and well-being of the dogs.

#### Veterinary care for dogs.

The facility does not have a written Program of Veterinary Care. Failure to have a written Program of Veterinary Care does not ensure the animals are receiving appropriate and adequate veterinary care which could have a negative impact on their health and well-being. A sampling of parasites and other pests is not being taken in accordance with a schedule from the attending veterinarian. A complete physical examination from head to tail of each dog is not being conducted in a 12 month period by the attending veterinarian.

Each dealer must follow an appropriate program of veterinary care for dogs that is documented in writing and signed by the attending veterinarian. The applicant must develop a written program of veterinary care that is signed by the attending
