### Veterinary care for dogs.

The licensee has a signed program of veterinary care for the schedule, dosage and products to be used for deworming and vaccination protocols. However, the facility is using another schedule of use for the deworming protocols that is different than the attending veterinarian has approved in writing.

It is important that the licensee follows the approved program of veterinary care as prescribed by their attending veterinarian. Any deviations in schedule, dosage or products from the approved attending veterinary program of care could cause health issues or a lack of protection involving deworming or vaccinations.

Each dealer, exhibitor, and research facility must follow an appropriate program of veterinary care for dogs that is developed, documented in writing, and signed by the attending veterinarian. If the licensee is going to utilize a different schedule for deworming or vaccinations, it must be documented in writing and approved by the attending veterinarian and kept with the program of veterinary care.

#### Veterinary care for dogs.

The licensee does not have complete medical records on all of the dogs at the facility that includes the dates of deworming, heart worm prophylaxis or vaccinations.

It is important to keep updated and accurate records of the worming, vaccination and heartworm prophylaxis provided and the dates they were given to each regulated animal. The lack of complete records, including dates given could cause a regulated animal to be over or under dosed, or missed completely in the deworming/vaccination or heartworm protocol.

Medical records must include the names of all vaccines and treatments administered and the dates of administration.
